S3-Link File Explorer Setup

Introduction

This guide is used to enable the S3-Link File Explorer component within the S3-Link application. The S3-File Explorer component will allow users to create folder structures for the Salesforce record and also upload and download files inside those folder structures.

Prerequisite

To enable this component for your end users, you will have to add the **S3-File Explorer** component to the Salesforce record detail page. For example, if you want to enable it for Account records, follow the below steps.

- 1. Go to the Accounts tab and open the account record
- 2. Click on Setup
- 3. Click on the Edit Page
- 4. Drag & drop the S3-File Explorer component to the account record page(if missing)
- 5. Click Save

Functionality Overview


You can enable various capabilities of File Explorer by following the below steps. There are a lot of other features which can be really useful. Below are some of those features with the steps you need to follow to enable them.

Auto Create Subfolders for Salesforce Record

If you want to auto create a set of subfolders under the Account name folder, please follow the below steps.


- 1. Follow the steps in the Prerequisite
- 2. Click on the S3-File Explorer component

Give comma separated sub-folder names in Sub-Folder Names property of the S3-File Explorer component like Agreements,Invoices,Images



4. Click **Save** & activate the page

Notes: After this, if the Account Name folder is yet not created for some account then the Create button will create an Account name folder and under that, it will create Agreement, Invoice & Images folders. See the below screenshot.




Enable/disable File Actions

You can enable and disable the File level actions in File Explorer for your end users. Follow the below steps for that.


- 1. Follow the steps in the Prerequisite
- 2. Click on the S3-File Explorer component
- 3. Give comma separated action names in the **File Actions** property of the S3-File Explorer component. It supports the actions below.

Detail, Preview, Download, Edit, New Version, Delete, Send Email, Copy, Move, Open Link, Public Link



4. Click **Save** & activate the page



Enable/disable Folder Actions


You can enable and disable the Folder level actions in File Explorer for your end users. Follow the below steps for that.

- 1. Follow the steps in the Prerequisite
- 2. Click on the S3-File Explorer component
- 3. Give comma separated action names in the **Folder Actions** property of the S3-File Explorer component. It supports the actions below.
 - Detail, Upload Files, Create Folder, Upload Folder, Clone Folder, Preview, Download, Edit, Delete, Refresh, Sync Files



4. Click **Save** & activate the page


Notes: After this, when users click on the menu for S3-Folder in File Explorer, they will see those actions you have enabled. See the below screenshot.




Show count of items under S3-Folders

If you want to display the total count of folders and files inside each folder, follow the below steps.

- 1. Follow the steps in the Prerequisite
- 2. Click on the S3-File Explorer component
- 3. Set the **Show Files/Folders Count** checkbox to true
- 4. Click **Save** & activate the page




Notes: After this, the total count of folders and files will be displayed for each S3-Folder in File Explorer. See below screenshot



Enable S3-Link Recycle Bin for S3-File Delete action

If you want the files deleted from S3-File Explorer to go into S3-Link Recycle Bin, please follow the below steps.

- 1. Follow the steps in the Prerequisite
- 2. Click on the S3-File Explorer component
- 3. Set the Enable S3-Link Recycle Bin checkbox to true



4. Click **Save** & activate the page

Notes: After this, if users delete the S3-File in File Explorer, they will go into the S3-Link Recycle Bin and stay there for 60 days before it gets deleted permanently from Salesforce and AWS. You can also restore

those deleted S3-Files from the S3-Link Recycle Bin if you want. If you do not have the guide for the
