Introduction

This guide is used to enable setting to send and Upload / Download links in the email.

Setup

Please follow below steps to send Salesforce links for file downloads in the email.

- **Create a Public Salesforce Site(if not available)**
 1. Go to Setup > Sites
 2. Click **New**
 3. Provide Site Label, Site Name & Active Site Home Page
 4. Click **Save**
 5. Open Site detail
 6. Click **Public Access Settings**
 7. Click **View Users**
 8. Open Site Guest User detail
 9. Go to Permission Set Assignment section
 10. Click **Edit Assignments**
 11. Assign "S3-Link User Real Only" permission set
 12. Click **Save**

- **Enable Public Site URL**
 1. Go to Setup > Custom Settings > Application Configuration > Manage
 2. Click New
 3. Provide below values and click **Save**
 - **Name:** Public Salesforce Site URL
 - **Configured Value:** {Copy & paste Site URL}
 - **Description:** URL of public Salesforce site which will be used to download S3 files using password protected links.
 - **Display Layout:** Simple Text
 - **Label:** Public Salesforce Site URL
 - **System Configuration?:** True
